Ashoka Business School, Nashik is the MBA Institute affiliated to the Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune since 2012. In reference to the above subject, we wish to bring the following issue to your notice which we are facing right now. It is crucial from the student's perspective and also from the Institute's perspective.

As per the course structure of the MBA program under the University, students have to undergo the 8 weeks of Industry Internship after their exams of Sem II. The exams for the Sem II are over recently. Now industries are having openings for internships which is a positive sign where students would get the opportunity to have experiential learning and hands-on industry experience which is one of the MBA program outcomes.

**But we are facing following problems in this regard-**

1. Most of the industries are asking for a minimum internship of 3 months which is more than the time frame prescribed in the course structure.

2. Again very few companies are ready for beginning the internships before Diwali. Most of the companies are allowing students to join after Diwali.

Above issues are putting students in a dilemma over getting experiential learning opportunities on one side and to follow the academic schedule on the other.

We humbly request you to throw light on this genuine issue of the students. We request you to commence the academic sessions of Sem III from the last week of Jan 2022 so that the students will get the opportunities to work in industry without any academic loss.
