7.1.3 the facilities in the Institution for the management of the following types of

degradable and non-degradable waste

ABS operations have a minimal environmental impact as the university is highly committed to

reducing waste generation and promoting recycling through a system that allows materials to

be reused, ensuring a lower consumption of natural resources. The college has categorized

waste into three types:

1. Solid Waste

Solid waste generated from routine college activities, including paper, plastics, glass, metals,

and food, is carefully segregated at the source. Administrative supervisors on each floor

oversee waste collection at designated intervals. Safai workers on each floor are responsible

for cleaning, segregating, and compiling the waste into color-coded dustbins (green and blue).

The segregated waste is then transferred to larger containers for each block and taken to the

designated dumping yard. ABS works with an authorized vendor who collects the segregated

waste, recycles it, and disposes of it at government-approved landfills.

2. Liquid Waste:

The institution is committed to maintaining an environmentally sustainable campus by

implementing an efficient liquid waste management system. This system ensures that all liquid

waste generated on campus, including wastewater from restrooms, kitchens, is treated and

disposed off responsibly to minimize its environmental impact. The system is connected to

Central Sewage line for better disposal of liquid waste.

3. E-Waste Management

ABS manages electronic waste (e-waste) such as flip-flops, memory chips, motherboards,

compact discs, cartridges, and components from devices like computers, radios, TVs, phones,

printers, fax machines, and photocopiers. Instead of purchasing new equipment, the college

opts for a buyback option for technology upgrades. Any e-waste that cannot be reused or

recycled is disposed of through "Techeco Company", Nashik.
