

Policy Document on Environment and Energy Usage (Policy for Green Campus, Energy/Waste/Water Conservation, Management and Awareness)

Ashoka Business School is committed to managing energy in a way that minimizes its negative effects on the environment. The school undertakes various steps and activities to manage environmental and energy usage. All stakeholders participate to ensure the success of this policy. Everyone understands their responsibilities and contributions towards its successful implementation.

The following initiatives are promoted under this policy:

- Assessing energy usage and its impact on the environment.
- Reducing carbon dioxide emissions in the campus from vehicles by promoting battery-operated vehicles, public transportation.
- Installing photovoltaic solar panels to generate alternate energy.
- Installing LED bulbs and lights in and around campus to save energy.
- Undertaking tree plantation drives.
- Ensuring lights and fans are switched off when leaving classrooms rooms, corridors, washrooms.
- Developing a systematic waste-solid, liquid and e-Waste management mechanism.
- Developing a rainwater harvesting (directly in ground).
- Maintaining electrical switches and other electrical appliances regularly.
- Continuously improving energy consumption measures.
- Ensuring the availability of necessary resources to achieve the objectives.
- Encouraging the use of available technology to minimize energy consumption.
- Engaging in dialogue with external institutions/ agencies and municipal corporations on environmental, energy efficiency, social awareness, and sustainable development issues.
- Strengthening employees' and students' environmental knowledge and skills to improve environmental performance.
- Providing information and training opportunities to admin staff on energy-saving measures.
