Sr. No	Action taken	Achievement
1.	Minimum use of papers	Paper usage has been reduced, as no unnecessary prints are taken by staff. Wherever possible, both sides of papers are used as well as rough papers are used.
2.	Tree Plantation activities	Tree plantation is carried out on campus and out of campus from time to time. This has helped in improving the air quality, reducing pollution, maintaining ecological balance, and also helping in preventing soil erosion.
3.	Eco-friendly Practices.	Each Guest who comes to the Campus is Welcome by the Plant Sapling and not by any Floral Bouquet. Useful Plant is offered to all the guest, who comes to interact with the students for knowledge sharing. Every year this workshop is conducted wherein students are trained to make idols from mud. This has helped in creating awareness amongst students forrefraining from the use of POP idols.
4.	Plastic-free campus initiatives	Plastic-free activities have helped in the generation of minimum plastic waste on the campus. Through notices, students are informed not to use plastics, and also, it is monitored that no plastic bags are used by the students and staff as well.
5.	Cleanliness Drive	The Institute had organized Cleanliness Drive with the students and staff – “ Goda Ghat Cleaning “ in association with Sakal Media Group. The campus and building are always maintained in a cleanstate. Regular cleaning is done by the assigned staff. Besides, the cleanliness drive has helped instill a sense of the importance of cleaning and hygiene in students. An initiative on Swachhta Education & Practice has been organized in the institute with the help of students and staff.
