

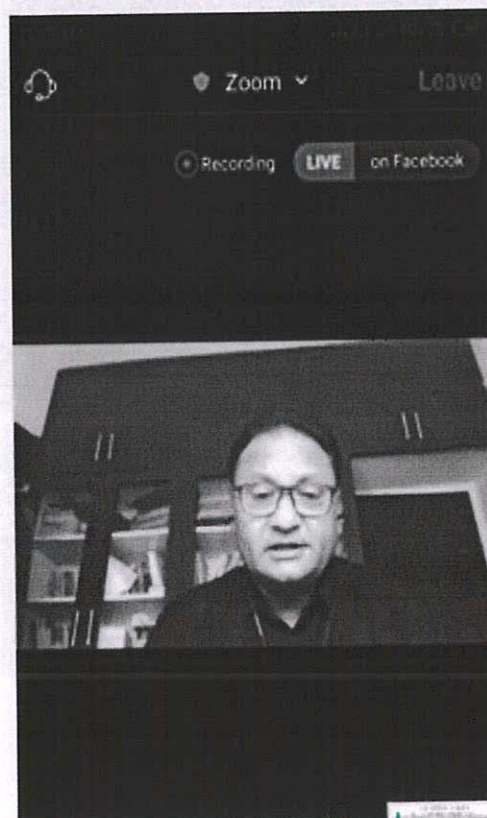
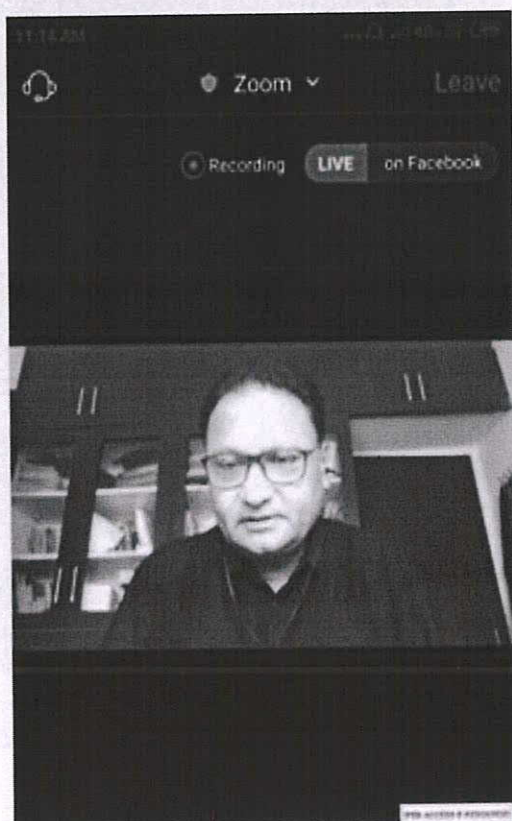
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Online User Awareness Programme on Open Access e- Resources

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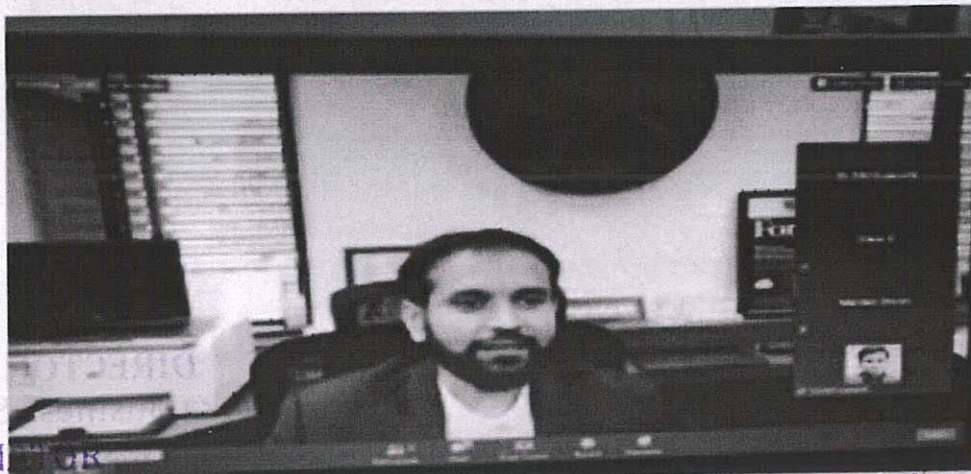
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Webinar on 'Changes Call for Innovation'
