(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party') as

#### WHEREAS:

- A) First Party is a District Level Government Body: District Industries Centre, Nashik.
- B) District Industries Centre (DIC) Nashik & Ashoka Business School believe that collaboration and co-operation between them will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- C) The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of One District One Product branding and promotion.
- Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interests.
- E) Ashoka Business School, the Second Party is promoted by Ashoka Education Foundation, whose head office is situated at Ashoka Marg, Wadala Nashik. Head office administers in all 7 branches in Nashik. The Governing authorities function for all the branches from this office.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

#### CLAUSE 1: CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to them in branding and promotion of One District One Product (ODOP) of Nashik District developing awareness about ODOP among students and giving projects related to ODOP to students for developing their innovative and entrepreneurial side.

#### CLAUSE 2: SCOPE OF THE MoU

- 2.1 The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in branding and promoting One District One Product of the District. Both parties believe that close cooperation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
- 2.2 ODOP products of Nashik District: As per Industries department is concerned there is one Agriculture and Non-Agriculture ODOP product for a district. In Nashik the Agriculture ODOP product is Grapes which is also a GI product and Non-Agriculture ODOP product is Paithani Saree which comes under Handloom sector. Second Party's students will get an opportunity to work on both Agriculture and Non-Agriculture ODOP projects and do branding and promotion of the same

Any act on the part Ashoka Business School the Second Party after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be construed as an extension of this MOU
- 4.2 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.
