A blood Donation Camp

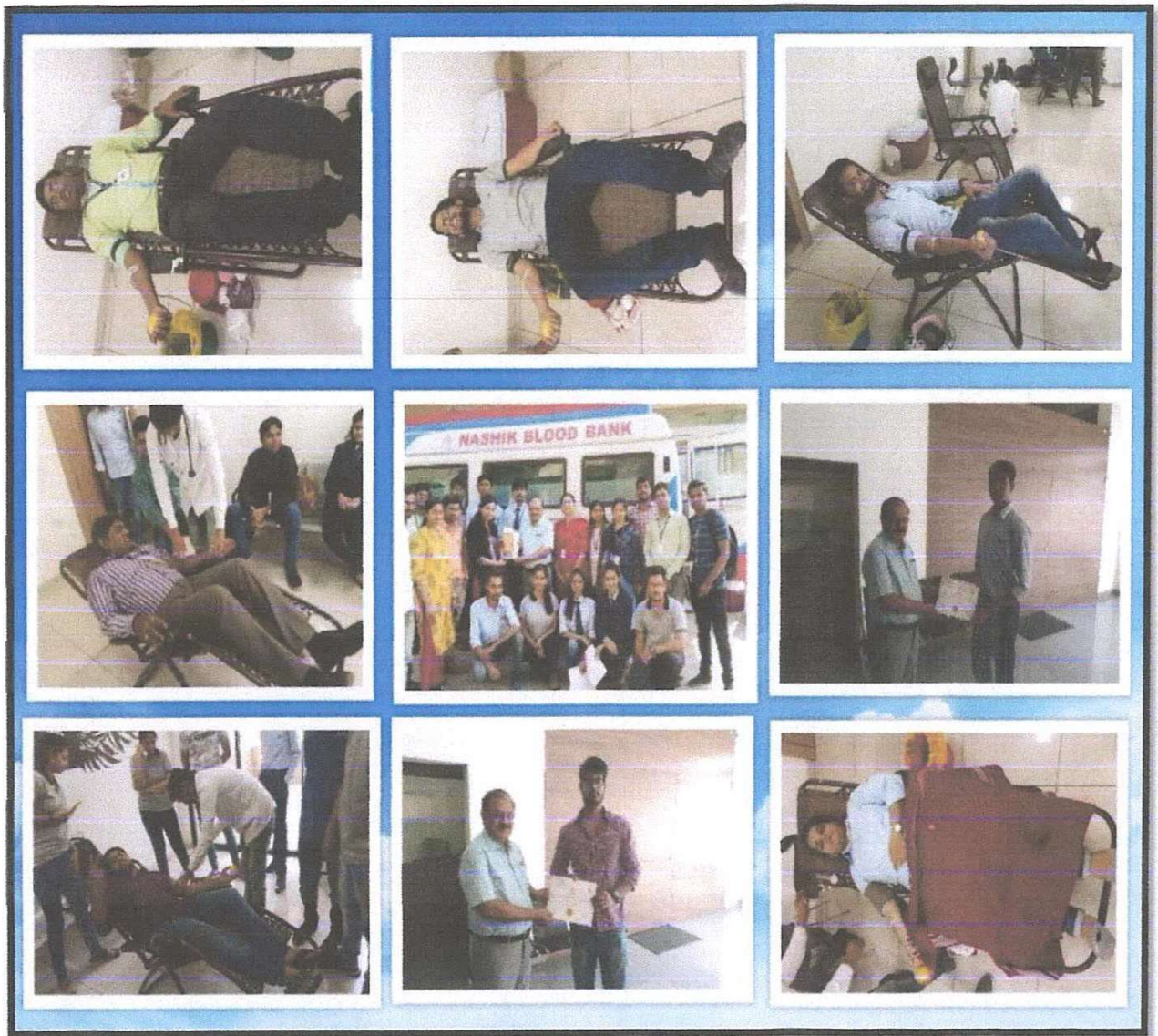
