

Code of Ethics to Check Plagiarism and Malpractices in Research Work

2. Nobody should claim credit for any other's research work in any form of publication or presentation.
3. Use of soft wares or any other mechanism to check the plagiarism is strongly recommended.
4. Faculties and Students should send their research papers for publication to the reputed and quality publishers only.
5. Library is equipped with several quality journals. The use of such journals should be increased as guidelines to improve the quality of research work.
6. The participation and related publication of research work in any of the conference/symposium/seminars must be done with the prior permission of the appropriate authority.
